Expungement/ Sealing Qualifications

- Evanston Resident
- Currently not on parole or probation
- No pending criminal or traffic case in court
- At least 3 years passed since last sentence completed (in order to seal)



What We Do

Qualified candidates may be eligible for criminal record expungement and/or sealing. Records that are expunged or sealed are no longer publicly accessible. Removing your criminal history increases your odds of finding employment, housing, and enrolling in certain college programs (e.g., nursing).
